Get to know the New Hamburg Mennonite Relief Sale

Each year on the last Friday and Saturday of May, the New Hamburg Mennonite Relief Sale (NHMRS) has welcomed over 10,000 attendees. The NHMRS started in 1967 in response to the ever-growing world wide need for relief from hunger, poverty and natural disaster, and for development and peace building activities. The proceeds from the New Hamburg Mennonite Relief Sale are forwarded to Mennonite Central Committee (MCC). The attendees visit many of the 40 venues which include a quilt auction, household auction, many delicious treats, plants and more. An estimated 2,000 volunteers donate their time and expertise while demonstrating their passion for assisting others in need.

Auctions

Hundreds of visitors raise their bidding cards to place bids on of auction items from quilts and tractors to gift certificates, paintings, and coffee machines. Our generous donors allow us to auction off such a diverse assortment of items and in 2023, allowed the relief sale auctions to raise over \$130,000 for MCC.

NHMRS Booklet

Over 6500 copies of the NHMRS visitor guide are distributed throughout southern Ontario through local businesses, churches, and visitors to the sale.









Mennonite Eats & Treats

Traditional Mennonite treats (fleisch piroschki, rolkuchen ϑ watermelon, apple fritters and more), ethnic foods (springs rolls, egg rolls, pupusa, Lao sausage, etc.) and new favourites (kettle chips, french fries, back bacon and more) are enjoyed during the sale. These treats are packaged in over 10,000 bags and boxes and are taken to a nearby picnic table or home to the dining room table to be enjoyed.

The Children's Area features games, a bouncy castle and more.

The Run for Relief draws dozens of runners testing their endurance and speed in 2 km and 5 km routes through picturesque New Hamburg. Run for Relief has raised several thousand dollars at the annual sale.

The song relates how the soy milk truck is coming, bringing the milk to them. In 2008, an MCC-funded shipment of 200 tons of soybeans was processed into protein-rich soy milk, boosting nutrition among children in orphanages, baby homes and daycare centers. MCC works through the Canadian organization First Steps, which distributed the soybeans and provided the equipment to make the soy milk.
