*Important Information About Pattern Copyrights

What is in a design: This is a very important thing to note on your quilt forms. Did you know that copying another person's pattern is similar to copying music or copying a book. Now that pictures of quilts are taken others are able to see if you used their pattern and will know if you had permission or not. Published patterns in books or magazines or individual patterns are generally okay – IF YOU SAY WHERE YOU GOT IT FROM!! But copying (reproducing) a quilt pattern taken off the internet may not be okay...you need to follow up with the person who made the design. Using a pattern without permission can be referred to as theft. There was a situation in the United States where the MCC auction had a "cease and desist" order from a lawyer (meaning don't use our pattern without permission or we will sue you!). We do not want to turn down a quilt donation BUT according to the law if you have not acknowledged the original designer and do not have their permission, we may not be able to use the quilt.
